Description:	The School Nurse makes scheduled visitations to both school buildings in the system weekly and is on call for any emergencies during school hours at both buildings
Role Model:	To serve as a role model for students in how to conduct themselves as Citizens and responsible intelligent human beings and the legal responsibility to help instill in students the belief in and practice ethical principles and democratic values

Essential Functions:

- To help maintain good health within the school district
- To organize all immunization and testing programs for students and faculty in cooperation with the County Health Department and State Department of Health
- To maintain and keep up to date files on individual health record
- To file health records in permanent files of students who have graduated or withdrew from school.
- To work effectively with drug and alcohol prevention
- To perform such duties as designated by the Superintendent of Schools.
- The employee shall remain free of any alcohol or non-prescribed controlled substance abuse in the workplace throughout his/her employment in the district
